Requirements for entrance into the Athenaeum:

Students:

- All students must present their Green Pass to enter the Athenaeum.
 - **Instead of a Green Pass**, one may also present a **certificate of complete vaccination (two doses)** given by the competent authority along with a document of personal identification.
 - **Instead of a Green Pass**, one may also present a **certificate of a negative Covid Test taken within the 48 hours before entrance to the Athenaeum**.
- Each person's body temperature will be taken, and those whose temperature exceeds or is equal to 37,5° C will not be allowed to enter.
- **Use of a surgical or FFP2 mask is obligatory** (FFP2 mask always recommended) during classes and in common areas.

Teachers/collaborators/guests:

- All teachers/collaborators/guests must present their Green Pass to enter the Athenaeum.
 - **Instead of a Green Pass**, one may also present a **certificate of complete vaccination (two doses)** given by the competent authority along with a document of personal identification.
 - **Instead of a Green Pass**, one may also present a **certificate of a negative Covid Test taken within the 48 hours before entrance to the Athenaeum**.
- Each person's body temperature will be taken, and those whose temperature exceeds or is equal to 37,5° C will not be allowed to enter.
- **Use of a surgical or FFP2 mask is obligatory** (FFP2 mask always recommended) during classes and in common areas.

It should be noted that the term Green Pass refers to the certification of complete vaccination that in other countries may have a different name.

Please note that the certifications issued by the health authorities of Canada, Japan, Israel, United States of America, Albania, Saudi Arabia, Armenia, Australia, Azerbaijan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brunei, United Arab Emirates, Jordan, Lebanon, Kosovo, Moldova, Montenegro, New Zealand, Qatar, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (including Gibraltar, Isle of Man, Channel Islands and British bases on the island of Cyprus and excluding territories not belonging to the European continent), Republic of Korea, Republic of North Macedonia, Serbia, Singapore, Ukraine, Taiwan, Special Administrative Regions of Hong Kong and Macao as well as those issued by

the competent authorities of the Republic of San Marino and the Vatican City State, following vaccination validated by the European Medicines Agency (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Johnson & Johnson) or recovery, are recognized as equivalent to the Italian ones;

All certifications must have the following content:

- identification of the holder (name, surname, date of birth).
- vaccine information (name and lot).
- date(s) of administration of the vaccine.
- identification information of who issued the certificate (State, Health Authority).
- The certification must be written in one of the following languages:

- Italian
- English
- French
- German
- Spanish
